- > Supervise any siblings during practices and races.

RYS is a volunteer-based, non-profit, youth sports organization. It is important that both runners and their parents follow the Code of Conduct to ensure that everyone feels safe to learn and have fun. Any violation of the Code of Conduct will result in one the following consequences for the **runner and parents**:

First Violation: Coach discusses infraction with runner and parent

Second Violation: Coach discusses infraction with runner and parent and provides written

documentation of offense(s) to the RYS Director. Suspension of one race or 1

week of practice.

Third Violation: Runner is suspended for the remainder of the season.

The runner may re-apply the following year.

Runners or Parents who violate the Code of Conduct may be asked to leave the premises and may not be allowed to participate in future RYS activities. The severity of the violation will dictate the severity of the consequence. (EG: Third violation consequence may be applied for first offense if violation actions deemed severe.)
