## Tournament Rules and Information

## 9U Tournament Rules

- All teams need to bring a box of 12 new baseballs for the tournament. These baseballs do not have to be RS-T, but need to be new in the wrapper. Please provide these to the Tournament Director on Friday and he will distribute the baseballs to all the fields throughout the tournament.
- The tournament shall consist of a eight team bracket, with the winning team moving forward and the losing team falling to a loser's bracket. Each team will play three games.
- Teams shall consist of 11-13 players, league age 9 and under, who played in a District 32 Minors division in 2019.
- All-star players are not eligible.
- All team members shall bat in a continuous order.
- Home and Visiting team will be determined by a coin flip prior to each game.
- The "infield fly rule" will be used.
- There is a 5 run maximum per half inning, with the exception of the sixth inning. The sixth inning will be an "open inning" and there will not be a 5 run maximum for this inning.
- All games are a 6 innings. If tied, a ${ }^{7 \text { th }}$ inning will be played (open inning). If after 7 innings, the game is still tied, the team that last held a lead after a completed inning will be declared the winner.
- The Green Book rule 4.10(e) for the 10 run rule will be used and if a home team is leading after 5 $1 / 2$ innings will not bat in the bottom of the 6th inning.


## Pitch Count Rules

- No pitcher may pitch more than three innings in one game.
- No player can pitch after catching any part of 4 or more innings in a day.
- A pitcher who delivers 41 or more pitches in a game cannot play the position of catcher for the remainder of that day.
- Maximum pitches for League Age 9 players is 75 per day and for League Age 8 it is 50 pitches.
- Required rest periods for pitchers as outlined in the 2019 green book will also be followed.


## Minimum Play Rules

- For teams with 11 or 12 players - players must play at least two innings of infield per game.
- Teams with 13 players - players must play at least one inning of infield per game.
- No player may sit out a second inning until every player has sat out one inning. No player may sit out a third time prior to every player sitting out a second time.
- The manager is required to provide defensive changes so that the scorekeeper can track minimum play.


## Reminders

- Teams must bring scorekeeper and announcer for each of the games.
- If you are the last game of the day, please make sure that the scorebooks are returned to the tournament shirt booth.
- Infield practice is a courtesy extended to both teams. The home team should take infield first, leaving the visiting team at least 10 minutes before the game to take infield. Umpires are to start games on time, regardless of whether teams have taken infield.
- No teams will be allowed to use the batting cages during the tournament.
- At the sole discretion of the Tournament Director, the schedule and team match-ups may be changed to avoid mismatches, avoid rematches of teams that have already played each other, accommodate conflicts and scheduling needs, or otherwise further the best interest of a fair, competitive, and enjoyable tournament experience for all teams.
- With the exception of the rules listed above, the tournament games will be conducted in accordance with the 2019 green book.
