OCEAN VIEW LITTLE LEAGUE GUIDELINE FOR BATTING CAGE USE

- 1. Adult supervision is required at all times when the batting cage is in use.
- 2. Cage time is limited to one-hour maximum.
- 3. No food, drink, or sunflower seeds will be consumed inside the batting cages.
- 4. Only OVLL Managers or OVLL Coaches are allowed to throw batting practice.
- 5. Only one batter and one pitcher are allowed in the cage at a time.
- 6. The pitcher must use an "L" fence protector or screen.
- 7. Access doors into the cage will be shut and latched prior to any pitch being thrown.
- 8. The batting cages access doors will be locked whenever they are not being used by an OVLL team.
- 9. Cleats are not allowed inside the cages.
- 10. Helmet use by batters is mandatory.
- 11. The only one to hold a bat will be the batter in the cage; all others will leave the bats on the ground, i.e. no swinging bats outside the batting cage.
- **Any violation of these rules will result in the loss of the privilege to use the OVLL batting cages**
