Infield Fly Rule	Occurs when there is 1 out or less, with runners on first and second (or first, second, and third). If called by umpire; batter is out, runners can advance at the risk of being put out.					
Obstruction	When a fielder clearly without possession of the ball blocks the batter / runner's path.					
Interference	Runner whether intentional or not alters the fielders play on batted ball or runner contacts ball before fielder.					
Avoiding Contact	If a fielder in possession of the ball attempts to tag a runner, the runner must slide or attempt to avoid the contact. If a runner does not avoid a fielder in possession of the ball the runner is out.					
Sliding	Cannot advance with a head first slide, but may return to a base.		May advance with a head first slide.			
On Deck Batter	Not Allowed except Lead Off Batter for each Inning			Allowed		
Leaving Early	May not leave the base until ball has reached the batter.			May lead off
