

Concession Stand Safety Policy

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure a safe, sanitary, and well-supervised environment within the concession stand for volunteers, patrons, and the community. Adherence to these guidelines helps prevent injuries, food safety incidents, and fire hazards.

Supervision and Staffing

- No person under the age of 16 is permitted behind the concession stand counter at any time.
- An approved adult must be present in the concession stand at all times to provide supervision.
- All volunteers working in the concession stand must complete required training and have an approved background check.

Training and Oversight

- Volunteers will be trained in safe food preparation practices and the proper, safe use of all concession equipment.
- The Concession Manager and Safety Officer are responsible for providing and overseeing all required training.

Equipment and Fire Safety

- All cooking equipment will be inspected periodically and repaired or replaced as necessary.
- Propane tanks must be turned off at the grill immediately after use.
- Cooking grease will be stored in approved containers and kept away from open flames.
- A certified fire extinguisher suitable for grease fires will be placed in plain sight at all times.
- All concession stand workers will be instructed on the proper use of fire extinguishers.
- Grill hoods and the Ansul fire suppression system will be cleaned and inspected after each season.
- All heating-element appliances must be shut off at the close of the concession stand.

Food Safety and Handling

- Only food purchased and prepared by Shelton Little League may be sold in the concession stand.
- Proper handwashing is required for all volunteers and must be performed frequently when handling food.
- Food service–approved vinyl gloves must be used in addition to regular handwashing.

- Cleaning chemicals must be stored separately and away from all food storage and preparation areas.

Emergency Preparedness

- A fully stocked first aid kit and ice packs will be readily available in the concession stand at all times.
- The main entrance door of the concession stand must never be locked or blocked while people are inside.

Compliance

All volunteers and staff are expected to follow this policy at all times. Failure to comply with these safety requirements may result in removal from concession stand duties.
