Roles During Emergency

During any emergency, the immediate care of the person in distress is the top priority. The most qualified individual on site will provide care, and all other personnel should follow their direction.

Emergency equipment may be retrieved by anyone who knows its location.

A call to 911 may be made by any calm, clear-communicating individual, who should remain on the line with the dispatcher until emergency responders arrive.

Someone should be designated to meet the emergency personnel and direct them to the site of the emergency.

Additional individuals should be designated to keep athletes and bystanders a safe distance away from the incident.

Finally, someone should be responsible for documenting the incident. Documentation should occur as soon as possible while details are fresh.

When to Call 911

No breathing, cardiac arrest, allergic reaction, unconsciousness, spinal injury, severe bleeding, heat stroke, fire, active threat, **when in doubt call 911.**

AEDs & First Aid Supplies

AEDs and additional first aid kits are located at

Sunnyside field - Concession stand building. The door has an AED and first aid stickers. left wall of the main entrance. First aid kit hanging below AED.

Nike Site - Concession stand building, inside garage, left wall. AED and first aid stickers on garage door. First aid kit hanging below AED.

Mingrone Field - Concession stand building. The door has an AED and first aid stickers. Right wall inside main entrance. First aid kit hanging below AED.

Emergency Action Steps

Immediately stop play, evaluate the condition of the individual, activate EMS as needed, administer appropriate care, direct responders to the location, secure the area, and thoroughly document the incident.

Post-Incident Procedures

Complete the incident report, notify league officials, replace any used equipment, conduct a debrief, and update the Emergency Action Plan as needed.
