

There are three required trainings for all Little League Head Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Managers, and Umpires: **Abuse Awareness**, **Diamond Leadership**, and **CDC Concussion** training. Coaches are also required to sign the Coaches Code of Conduct, which [can be found here](#). Details for each are provided below.

NOTE: to access the links in this document, hold the Ctrl button and click the link.

Abuse Awareness Training

This training is completed through *Little League University*, **must be completed annually**, and expires in October each year.

- If you completed this training **before October 2025**, you will need to retake it for the 2026 season.
- If you already have a Little League University account, you can [login here](#).
- Otherwise, you will need to [register here](#).
- Once you're in the **Learner Dashboard**, select "All" in the **Courses** section on the left side to find the available training courses.

Diamond Leadership Training

This training is also completed through *Little League University*, only needs to be completed once, and does not expire.


CDC Concussion Training

This training is through the *CDC* and must be completed at least once every three years.


- If you completed it in **2023 or later**, you do not need to repeat it.
- If you have a CDC account, you can [login here](#).
- Otherwise, you'll need to [register here](#).
- Once logged in, search for: **"HEADS UP to Youth Sports: Online Training for Coaches."**

Once you complete the trainings be sure to save the certificates you receive so they can be uploaded to your volunteer account as shown below.


1. Register or login to your account at <http://www.harborbaseball.com>. If you registered a child for Little League you should already have an account, otherwise you will need to create one. Note that EACH volunteer must have their own account and training certificates.




2. Select the Volunteer button in the left banner.



3. From there click the blue box that says “Find Volunteer Roles”, click the “View Divisions” box (either Baseball or Softball), and then select a Division. **If you are a general volunteer that is not assigned to a Division, such as an umpire or board member, select the Baseball program and Junior Division.**



4. Next select your volunteer role.



5. Finally, complete the Volunteer Registration and upload your certificates for the Abuse Awareness, Diamond Leader, and CDC Concussion trainings. **Coaches also need to upload their signed Coaches Code of Conduct form.** Don't forget to click "Continue" and "Save". That's it, you're done!
