

To: **Interested Managers of Merritt Island Little League Baseball Teams**

Re: 2026 Manager Application Form

The Little League manager and coach must be leaders. All must recognize that they hold a position of trust and responsibility in a program that deals with a sensitive and formative period of a child's development. It is required that the manager and coach have understanding, patience and the capacity to work with children. The manager and coach should be able to inspire respect. Above all else, managers and coaches must realize that they are helping to shape the physical, mental and emotional development of young people.

No other volunteer in MILL has a more direct impact on our young athletes than the Manager. He or she must be a leader, a teacher, a role model and an inspiration. We are looking for Managers who not only possess knowledge of baseball fundamentals and the ability to teach those fundamentals, but, more importantly, individuals who will instill a sense of self-confidence, pride and accomplishment in our young athletes.

Our objective is to implant firmly in the children of the community the ideals of good sportsmanship, honesty, loyalty, courage and respect for authority, so that they may be well adjusted, stronger and happier children and will grow to be good, decent, healthy and trustworthy citizens. Our fundamental priority is that children who enter the MILL program will benefit from their experience, not just in their development as ballplayers, but also in terms of their development as individuals. MILL invites you to apply to become a MILL Manager by completing the attached form.

All Manager positions are selected annually. All appointments to serve as Manager or Coach expire on December 15th annually. No Manager or Coach has any tenure whatsoever, regardless of years of service to MILL. As such, the President and Board of Directors may not provide reasons to any candidate if that person is not re-appointed or selected as Manager or Coach for the coming season.

The process for Manager selection is as follows:

1. Interested applicants must complete the following attached form manager application form. A Little League Volunteer Application form will follow.

Please note that the Little League Volunteer Application must include a copy of a government issued picture identification (e.g., driver's license)

2. Applications will be reviewed by the MILL Manager Selection Committee. The Vice President or Coaching Coordinator may contact the candidate for a phone interview and may contact references listed on the Manager Application Form for additional candidate information.

3. The President, in consultation with the Manager Selection Committee, will prepare a slate of recommended Managers and present the recommendation to the MILL Board of Directors.

4. The MILL Board of Directors will consider the recommendation of the President and approve a slate of Managers.

5. Selected Managers will be notified by the Coaching Coordinator. Notification of mandatory Manager Meetings will be communicated at that time.
