DRESS CODE

Little League Baseball Tournaments

1. Pants or shorts:
 - a. Pants or shorts must be hemmed and the same, solid color for the manager and coach(es).
 - b. Shorts must be within 2" of the knee.
 - c. Docker type pants, slacks or hemmed shorts are preferred.
 - d. Cargo type pants or hemmed shorts will be allowed.
 - e. Denim (jeans) type pants and shorts are NOT allowed.
2. Shirts:
 - a. Collared shirts or team jersey will be required.
 - b. Shirts must be the same solid color for the manager or coach(es).
 - c. Shirts must be tucked into the pants or shorts.
 - d. Tee-type shirts and tank tops are NOT allowed.
3. Footwear: Open toed shoes, thongs or sandals are NOT allowed.
4. Hats:
 - a. Team hats will be required for managers and coaches.
 - b. Hats will be worn with the bill facing forward.
5. Exception:

Intermediate (50-70) and Junior League: Managers and coaches may wear full team uniforms. If not in uniform, the same dress code for Little League applies.

Any manager or coach who does not conform to the dress code will NOT be allowed on the playing field or in the dugout before or during the game.

The purpose of the dress code is to ensure an acceptable uniform appearance of all participants and to promote a positive role model for the players and spectators at the tournament site.
