## Protocol and Procedures for JCLL during COVID19

### JCLL

- JCLL will follow the resumption guideline and city or other local rules or requirements.
- Once JC Parks and Rec Director has given permission to play games we will start. Anticipated date for games to start June 22, 2020.
- Practice may be held on fields and batting cages or areas around the fields till games can resume. Please keep all practices to players and coaches only, spectators are to remain in their vehicles.
- Always Maintain social distancing, keep six feet of separation when possible, other methods such as mask are recommended when separation not feasible.

### Facility

- Bleachers will be mark for proper seating spacing, remain in your cars when possible.
- JCLL will provide hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes, soap and water bucket stations around the park.
- League will post notices around the concession stand and fields to remind visitors and players to take steps to prevent the spread of COVI19.
- Only two concession stand workers at once allowed in, salesperson must wear mask and gloves when handling foods. Cooks must wear, hairnets, facial mask or covering and gloves always.
- Minimum of 2 board members at Wilkie Park, minimum of 1 board members at Smith Park per game.
- Fields should be mowed more frequent as to help stop the growth of any plants or weed with pollen that may cause sneezing.

### Players and Coaches

- Everyone should take measures to prevent all but the essential contact necessary to play the game. This should include but not limited to handshakes/high fives after games but encourage to tip the hats after all games.
- Players bat or equipment bags will remain on the outside of the dugout as to avoid unnecessary contact.
- Player should have their own batting helmets, gloves, bat, catchers mask and base ball cap. Measures should be made to avoid equipment sharing.
- All league batting helmets, bats or training equipment will be disinfected after every team use by the team and made available to the next team or coach.
- Coaches should give the previous team ample time to clean the dugout before entering the field.
- Practices should be kept to a minimum to avoid long exposure to other players.
