Proposal to mandate the invitation of any umpire assigned by the East Region to any Regional Tournament or World Series to officiate at the corresponding State Tournament.

The State Committee recommends that membership approve a proposal to mandate an invitation be made to any umpire assigned by the Regional Office to a Regional or World Series to officiate at the corresponding State Tournament.

- A committee of DA's and Section Umpire Consultants met on February 22nd and recommended that the proposal be presented to State Committee.

Pros:

Improves quality of officiating at the State Tournament.
Prepares individual umpire for Regional / World Series taking place in the near future.

Con:

May limit the number of local umpires that may be used in that state tournament.
