Umpires Recommended For Regional Tournaments

A New Jersey District Administrator recommendation for an umpire to work in a Regional Tournament must first meet the following New Jersey state requirements.

1. The umpires being recommended must first serve as an umpire in a New Jersey State Tournament as one of the four section umpires (shown on sheet #7 Blue Book – “Umpire selections in State Tournaments”). He/She may umpire in any of the ten (10) State Tournaments.
2. After meeting the state requirements in paragraph one above the umpire can only be recommended to the Regional office to umpire in the same level (division) of play of the Regional Tournament or a lower level (division) of play in the Regional Tournament that he umpired in New Jersey. If umpires worked in state 9/10 or 11 yr old Tournaments they can only be recommended for the Regional 11/12 yr old Tournament.
3. The Regional office shall not approve a District Administrator request / recommendation for anyone to umpire in a Regional Tournament or above until the umpire has fulfilled his umpire obligation for New Jersey State Tournaments.

Examples:

1. A person who has umpired in a State Junior League Tournament may request to umpire in a Regional Junior League Tournament or a Regional Little League Tournament.
2. A person who umpires in a State 9 & 10 year old Tournament or a State 11 year old Tournament may request to umpire in a Regional 11 & 12 year old Tournament but not a higher level Regional Tournament.
3. Exception: A person who umpires in a State Senior League Tournament may request to umpire in any Regional Tournament including Regional Big League Tournament.
