3.	<p>OLD:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Complex Update – New appliance will be installed in the concession. Hood is being put in. Kevin and Angela made a punch list and Kevin’s crew is working on it. Meeting room needs flooring. The Board discussed getting sliding glass windows for the front on concession stand instead of roll-up doors in order to keep the ac inside the building. Kevin will get an estimate. Health inspection needs to be done before any cooking can be done. Batting cages need to be put up with locations TBD. Randy Tingler wants a sign put up at the complex. ○ Baseball – Maurice Holland reminded everyone about registration. ○ Safety – Scott Kern reported that he will get the safety report to Jimmy Straley once the ice and snow is off the field. Scott also reminded everyone about the safety concern of kids being hit with bats. There are no on deck batters. Batters pick up at bats before going to plate. Coaches need to peer check at practices and games.
