3.	<p>OLD:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Complex Update – Getting volunteers is hard. Same people all the time. Volunteers need to contact Kevin, Jeff or Brandon. Concession equipment – a hood was going to be installed which cost \$25,000. Brandon Groome came up with an alternative of a ventless deep fryer for \$15,000. A traditional stove is pointless. Blackstone for burgers and hot dogs and a warming station. S&K Sips would be willing to sell food until the concession stand is up and running. They would even come to practices. The sediment filter will need to be checked occasionally by the concession workers. ○ During games when concession is open there would need to be 2 parents from each home team, and they can work in shifts. ○ A flooring company donated all trim and carpet for meeting room. ○ Charlie Kemp donated a slightly used riding mower for Luck Field. ○ Jeff Marshal reported that Barton and Boyd would be re-grading the road and parking lot. ○ Screening for back stops, batters' eye, bull pen and back of dugouts need to be up.
