o Jerseys

- Would like to move away from major/minor league teams to standard Plum Slow Pitch Softball jerseys. Priced jerseys outside of AD Starr and they are cheaper, would be available in 10 days.
- AD Starr can produce the appropriate turn around time if order is placed 3/12
- Deanna requested a breakdown of cost per player for softball. Julie can look into this.
- Joe to work with Ryan on setting up the divisions in the new slow pitch age format
