



Dear Senior,

Maple Valley Pony Baseball and Fastpitch (MVPBAF) is offering an opportunity for graduating seniors or the equivalent to receive a scholarship of up to \$1500.00

**Minimum criteria for consideration are:**

**Scholarships:** In the spirit of our mission, Maple Valley PONY Baseball and Fastpitch (MVPBAF) will offer graduating students who are continuing their education either through a University, Accredited College, or Vocational School, an opportunity to apply for our scholarship program. The maximum amount to be paid out in a calendar year in total is not to exceed \$3000. The maximum per person is \$1500 for baseball and \$1500 for fastpitch.

Qualified applicants must submit an application to MVPBA no later than April 30th. Applications will be reviewed and awarded by the voting board on or before May 31st.

Applications for the scholarship program can be obtained from the website. Minimum criteria for consideration are:

- A. The applicant must be graduating from high school or equivalent in the current year and be continuing their education following high school through a University, Accredited College, or Vocational School.
- B. Applicants must have participated in the MVPBAF Program for a minimum of 5 years.
- C. The applicant must have participated in MVPBAF Program until they reached the Pony level (13-14 years old) or MVP Tournament Teams 13U.
- D. Program participation having less than 5 years, requires volunteer hours as an assistant, clinic support person, or specialized instructional coach (minimum of 20 hours per year until total years of play plus volunteer years is equal to or greater than 5 total years).
- E. Participation in MVPBAF Baseball Program participation may be combined with Fastpitch Program years of service.
- F. At least 1 letter of recommendation (high school facility member, coach or community person ect.)
- G. If an applicant has been awarded the MVPBAF Scholarship in a previous year, they will only be considered for the current year's scholarship if no other applicants apply.
