- ☐ Important Spring Dates
  - ☐ The proposed dates are based off of last years dates and are as follows:
    - ☐ Jan 9 - backup assessment in the evening by appt only
    - ☐ Jan 10 and Jan 11- Main assessments

- Regular schedule – 7 weeks of games – 2 games per week
  - Planning to schedule 12-14 games which does not include playoffs
  - This should allow 1 practice per team and 2 games/week. Having 630pm games allow for Teenagers (umpire) to make games and allow for teams to practice.
    - We typically don't get much notice if the District 31 umpires will do our games, it is up to them. We are not able to plan for it.
  - Recommended that Majors and Minors only go through the week of 5/15/25
  - Rookies, Maps and T-ball can go beyond 5/15/25 date
  - For playoff weeks – can't play more than 2 games in a week
  - Will we do City championships?
    - PALL president is interested in rekindling these games
    - Could do from 5/16/25 on for City championship
    - It will depend on schedule
  - Will we do inter-league? For further discussions once we know how many teams we will have.
  - For the league to be eligible for All star – must have 12 scheduled games
