- ☐ Meeting was held via Zoom.
  - Called to order by Aaron S. at 6:30pm
- ☐ Finances
  - Our cuts are about 20k each for Fall ball for PNLL and PALL
  - We should come close to being even this year vs. last year being in the negative.
  - Still no invoice for All-star uniforms
  - Will have insurance coming up, which will be about 6k.
- ☐ Still in need of someone to take over sponsorships – Jenny will do it in the interim
- ☐ Fall Ball reviews if any
  - There have been a lot of schedule change requests
  - A parent offered to provide shade to the minor B fields.
- ☐ Disciplinary Meeting
  - Committee met – we had an act of vandalism between two parents. Kids on the same team, Tierra Bonita have parking spots that parents can pay to have during school events. Parent deflated the air in a tire. Committee agreed to move the one player. Parent being moved did not agree with being moved.
- ☐ Proposed Fundraiser
  - PALL parent reached out to propose a joint adult homerun derby. Everyone agreed it would be ok. Erin G. will reach out.
- ☐ End of Fall Ball BBQ/Sandlot Game
  - It's on the schedule, are we still doing it? Sunday, Nov 16<sup>th</sup>.

- ☐ Spring Registration
  - Headcount was just over 300 for 2025 spring season.
  - Suggestion by James if we alter the age groups or eliminate Minor B since we have MAPS. Minor A/Minor B is not actually part of Little league, it's just MAPS and Minor which you can allow different versions. We have too many kids that stayed down in Minor A. Rules are structured t-ball, rookies, MAPS (machine pitch) and Minors (kid pitched)
    - ☐ Suggestion to assess all kids 8 and up
    - ☐ Suggestion to assess 10,11,12 year olds to confirm if they can play majors
      - ☐ Asses 8 and 9 years old to determine Minor breaking out.

- ☐ Suggestion to set it up like Friday night lights, one age group could have multiple levels like red, blue, white
  - ☐ Should we ask coaches from last year to asses kids from their teams?
  - ☐ Provide a list of skills that coaches should teach – to ensure consistency
- ☐ 1<sup>st</sup> step – do we start a little earlier and do player evaluations – have any potential managers attend
- ☐ Registration for majors, minors, maps, rookies, tball – need to know our potential headcount
  - ☐ We know majors is 11's and 12s – 10's can play up, 12's can't go down.
  - ☐ 11 and 12 are in majors unless there is a safety concern
  - ☐ Minors –10
  - ☐ Maps – 8
  - ☐ Rookies –6
  - ☐ Tball – 5
  - ☐ Ok to allow younger kids to play up as long as they can asses up.
  - ☐ Chris T will pull together numbers and put together a google doc and ask managers to recommend what division each player should play in next year.
