Greetings to All,

We at Biddeford LL are very proud to be hosting this year's 11U boys State Tournament. As anyone who has hosted this event in the past knows, there is a lot of time and effort that goes into hosting a successful tournament. We have been very busy preparing this great event for all of you. We look forward to showing you a great time, and enjoying some great baseball as well. District Administrators, please print or forward this package to your District Champion team's manager immediately upon conclusion of your district tournaments.

We also have a State link on our website: www.biddefordlittleleague.com Please direct the players' families to our website to review and download the information package once registered! Managers will register all information for themselves and send emails to families to register online. This will help with communication to teams. TEAM MANAGER is the Application we will use to communicate to Managers and Teams. Please register online ASAP!

We would like to have **photos of all of the District winners** to put into our State program. I realize that this may be difficult as I have noticed that some of you will not have a champion determined until after July 14th. Our program will be going to the printer on July 15th, so obviously we will not have some of your photos in time. We may have a separate sheet with the team photos made up, and just add them to the book after the printing. PLEASE send me your photos and team rosters as soon as you have a champion. Just email them to me (Joshua Edgerton 207-590-5386) at bllmaine@gmail.com immediately after the last game. Please include contact information for the team Manager at this time as well. I will contact each manager directly as soon as I receive their contact information.

Some other key points in the schedule to emphasize:

Attire: Managers and coaches will be required to wear a long dress or khaki pants during the games. <u>Please no shorts or jeans</u>

The Manager Meeting July 19th at 6pm - 8pm 120 May Street Clubhouse Conf:

We need to invite all Managers and Coaches for each winning District team to our preparation meeting. Please bring your detailed Team Tournament Book including Team affidavits, and player verification information. Therefore attendance by all team managers is required at this event. Our District Administrator will organize a meeting of the 6 District Administrators during this 2 hour time period, which will take place at the site. We will have the umpire and coaches meeting, and the **coin flips for games 1** and 2 at approximately 7:45 to 8pm.

In addition we will have Opening Ceremonies Described in detail. Tournament staff will be on hand at the field to direct the teams to their positions for the next day. All teams will parade onto the field from the gate in the back corner of the field with their championship banners. Aunts and Uncles will help guide you through the process. Let the games begin!

We will use "Aunts and Uncles" during State week, just as Little League does at Regionals, and Williamsport. A member, or members of Biddeford LL will be appointed to each District team. These volunteers will accompany the team they are assigned to for all State events. They will be on hand to aid and answer any questions that you may have, especially during practices at our May St. facility. They will be on hand to unlock the facility for bathrooms or other emergencies, and direct the teams to their assigned practice areas. They will be a valuable asset in just getting around the city as well. Contact information for each Aunt and Uncle will be sent to each District Champion once all of the teams have been determined.

Biddeford Little League has two main field locations that will be used during the tournament, and both are designated on the maps provided. The Hill St. field will be the game site. No practices will be allowed on the Hill St. field except for the 10 minute infield each team will receive before each game. The May St. field will be the practice site. This complex has two batting cages and two fields back to back. Both teams will be assigned batting practice during the same time period. Each will be assigned to their own batting cage, and each will have use of a field for defensive work. Live hitting of regular baseballs is prohibited on Field #2. Your team Aunt or Uncle will be advised of the field assignments before each game, and will direct you to your assigned areas as you arrive for practice. The Tournament staff will monitor the use of the fields and try to balance the use of each field evenly between fields 1 and 2 for each team. Parking at the May St. field is limited, and parking in designated no parking areas will result in a ticket. Please obey the signs for your own good. Carpooling to practice would be a big help with both teams hitting together. Additional practice times for teams staying in Biddeford can be arranged through your team Aunt or Uncle. In addition to

our May St. practice facility, the Biddeford Middle School will also be available. The BMS field is located just up the road from Hill St. field. (see map) The BMS field will also require scheduling through your league Uncle to avoid conflicts with other teams.

The Start of the tournament is Saturday July 20th. We will begin the day with an Opening Ceremonies from 9:00 am to 11:00 am for League and District officials, umpires, and Managers and coaches. Our Hill Street Location and Canteen will have breakfast material and coffee. The Biddeford Primary, Intermediate, and Middle School is located on Hill St. just south of the game field.

On Saturday July 20th the annual **Shriners Lobster Bowl** will be played at Thornton Academy field, featuring the best football players from all over the State of Maine. This great event is played every year, with the proceeds of the game going to the Shriners Hospital for Children in Boston, Mass. The game begins at 4:00pm this year. Anyone interested in attending the Lobster Bowl game may have the opportunity to do so, Saco Thorton Academy is just a 15 minute drive from Hill St. Field.

Of course per Little League rules, the use of tobacco and alcohol is prohibited anywhere around the Little League facilities. Please advise the fans of your teams of this fact. <u>If anyone is suspected of drinking on the property, they will be asked to leave immediately.</u>

The **parking** at Hill St. field will be behind the ball field, with overflow parking available at the local schools just up the road from the field. Please remember that parking behind the ball field is at the owners risk. Any damage caused by balls leaving the field will not be covered by Little League insurance, or Biddeford Little League on vehicles that are parked at the field. **There is no parking allowed on Hill Street.**

For our guests with **younger children** that may need a break from watching the games, we have two playgrounds with slides, swings, etc. located within easy walking distance of the game field. The closest is located behind the field parking area at JFK school. This area is fenced in for safety. Just a little further up the road at our Biddeford Primary School is another playground with lots of activities as well. The BPS playground is not completely fenced in, but sits well off the road. Anyone of our staff can direct you to either playground.

We will have a local **photographer** on hand to take action photos during the games. The contact information is included in this package.

If weather becomes an issue, we will adjust the schedule as needed. The schedule will be adjusted at the discretion of the State Tournament staff. We will not schedule doubleheaders unless absolutely necessary. As advised by LL, during a lightning storm we will not resume play for 30 minutes after the last lightning flash is seen. When thunder or lightning is in the area, the field will be cleared and everyone must go to their vehicles. The dugouts are not safe during a thunderstorm. If this occurs, please instruct the players to remain in a vehicle until the all clear is announced.

As I am sure you can appreciate, running a State Tournament requires a considerable investment of both time and money from volunteers of Biddeford Little League. The only source of income we have is sales from our concessions stand. Please encourage your families to purchase food items on site. We do not allow food to be brought onto the complex.

The Biddeford LL staff is very anxious to meet all of you and your teams. Hopefully Mother Nature will cooperate and we will have a great week of baseball, and stay on schedule. <u>Hill St – 308 Hill Street (Game Field)</u>

- --take exit 32 of the Maine Turnpike
- --go straight thru lights onto Biddeford Connector -- (0 .9 miles)
- --go straight thru lights onto Precourt St -- (0.3 miles)
- --at stop sign take left onto Landry St -- (0.2 miles)
- --take first left onto Hill St. (Hill St. Field will be on the left) -- (1.1 miles)

May St – 120 May Street (Practice field)

- -- take exit 32 of the Maine Turnpike
- --take left onto Alfred St/ Route 111 at first light. -(1.1miles)
- --take left onto May St. (May St. Fields will be on the left) -- (0.4 miles)

Practice field (May St) to Game field (Hill St)

- --take Dartmouth St (directly across from batting cages) -- (0.2miles)
- --take right onto Elm St. (route 1) -- (0.2 miles)
- --travel in left lane thru first set of lights -- at second set of lights take left onto West St. -- (0.5 miles)
- --at next light take a right onto Hill St. (field will be on the right) (0.2 miles)


