Boys & Girls Clubs across the country name an outstanding boy or girl aged 14-18 as their Youth of the Year each year. Members at that age who consider themselves top candidates go through a rigorous selection process which involves writing essays, obtaining letters of recommendation, evaluating their impact in the community and at the Club and finally an interview process with a panel of judges. In 2018, we had three outstanding members become finalists; **Evan Campbell-Widmer, Bianca Medina and Karmen Canizales.**

Karmen Canizales was named our 2018 Youth of the Year in a ceremony in February and represented our Club at the Discovery Cube where the 15 Orange County Clubs had their winners give a speech and be judged to represent Orange County in a Statewide event, and for the eventual winner to be Boys & Girls Clubs of America's Youth of the Year. At every level participants and winners receive awards and scholarships toward college. Karmen received two \$1,000 scholarships for winning our competition, funded by our Ann Hansen Education Scholarship Fund, The Mike Meters Scholarship and by Disney.

Karmen told her incredible story of coming to the Club as a youngster and not liking it so much. She was hit in the head with a basketball on her first day here. But over time she would come to love the Club and now thinks of the staff like her family members. As she grew older she watched many of her peers and even her older brother make poor choices with drugs, alcohol and un-healthy decisions. She watched her older brother go to jail and used those experience and the influences of her Club mentors to stay involved through her High School years. Due to her hard work and participation in the Mark Schmitt College Bound Program, her dream of college became a reality. She earned a near full scholarship at San Francisco State University where she is a now a freshman.

Dear Families and Friends,

2018 will be remembered as a transitional year for the Boys & Girls Club of the South Coast Area. We said good-bye to a number of valued and quality employees who embraced life's opportunities with family and career changes. We wished Johnny, Nicole, Ian, Kyleigh and Christian well with their departures and look forward to their continued progress as great adults and role models from our community.



I completed my first full year here in California after an almost two-decade career with Boys & Girls Clubs on the East Coast. I have been very proud to carry on this Club's long standing reputation as a great place for kids to be. Thanks to the strong foundation and outstanding reputation established by Kent Campbell, one of my predecessors during 32 years of service as the Executive Director, the Club has become a valued part of the community fabric. Much was accomplished this past year while working very closely with our Board President, Larry Rannals, who brought a needed detailed approach to our organization, honed over his 26 years as a Marine officer and aviator, followed by another 22 years working at Camp Pendleton as a federal civilian employee.

We embraced the opportunity to serve more teens this past year through a re-introduction of our Youth Leadership Clubs, the Keystone and Torch Clubs, which engage our Club members in the community through leadership and civic projects. Our Mark Schmitt College Bound program boasts more than 30 members for the first time in its four-year history of helping High School Students gain acceptance into college and universities with financial aid packages. Additionally, our summer Leaders In Training program has grown substantially this past year. This program encourages young teens to pursue leadership opportunities within the Club's various younger member programs, while simultaneously teaching them the value of accountability, respect, initiative, and responsibility, all traits that are desired and valued in today's work force.

Most importantly, however, our success in 2018 can be mainly attributed to the many individuals and organizations within the community who continue to support the Club and our mission through generous giving. Last year saw an increase in the number of supporters and total dollars raised, which has allowed us to keep fees low and affordable to all. While last year's expenses still exceeded total revenue received, the increase in 2018 income over 2017 has allowed the Club to expand its impact by offering more opportunities for more children. 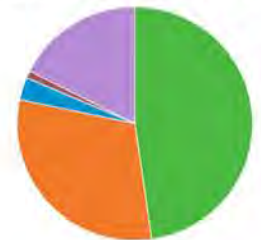
