Budget: (Kelly Chernowski)

Approval Vote – 2019 actual and 2020 proposed- Motion made, seconded and approved.

Kelly C. reviewed the high school budget for the 2019 season. Kelly C. stated that it usually costs more to play than what is included in the starting budget. Player fees are \$400, but the total expense per player is \$800. Fundraising is necessary to fully fund the budget/season. For the 2019 season, spirit wear sales and hosting middle school tournaments were the big money earners.

In the 2020 Budget overview, Kelly C. stated that the biggest change this season will be the addition of the Emory volleyball camp and the removal of all other summer camp/training activities from 2019 MS camp will stay the same. All fees will stay the same, kits are still included, and new uniforms will not be ordered for the 2020 season.

2020 Season Calendar: (Coach Feddersen)

Team Calendar - May through October

Coach Fedderson. reviewed the May through October 2020 season calendar. She stated there will be two days of try-out prep and she encouraged players who are interested in trying out to prepare by participating in a variety of fitness or strength training activities or by attending the variety of clinics offered by local volleyball clubs. Both the try-out prep and the try-outs do not have a fee, but all players must have a sports physical completed **AND** uploaded to ParentVue **prior** to trying out. Directions for uploading the completed physical will be shared with all interested parties. If you were on the team last year your physical from last year is still current but needs to be renewed to play on the teams in 2020.

Coach Fedderson encouraged both the parents and players to carefully look at the calendar for the purposes of planning around events such as the Emory camp, the middle school camp, Wildcat Daze,

practice/conditioning days and times, as well as fundraising volunteer date/needs.

Volunteer Needs: (Lisa Simpson) (Coach Feddersen)

Lisa S. spoke about the fundraising opportunities that require volunteers for the 2020 season.

The first need is for the car wash during teacher post-planning at WHS. The girls will wash the cars for the teachers and staff, but ADULTS are needed to move the cars.

The next need is for the Sponsorship Drive in which the players will ask for local businesses to sponsor the teams. Adult drivers are also need for this activity. Coach Fedderson added that this year the players will be responsible for making follow up phone calls to businesses that expressed interest in being sponsors (with adult assistance as needed).)

We will also be selling the Pura Vida bracelets and possibly spirit wear at Wildcat Daze which will require some adult supervision.

Other fundraising opportunities will be spirit days at local restaurant and both the middle school and high school will be selling Butterbraids.

Other volunteer needs include keeping score/line judging during games/tournaments.

Tryout Information: (Coach Feddersen)

Tryout Prep – Tue-Wed, May 4-5, 5:00pm-7:00pm Tryouts – Mon-Thu, May 11-14, 5:00pm-7:00pm

Kelly C. asked that players who wish to try out please complete the registration form once it is available. Players who register ahead of time and have uploaded the physical to Parentvue will move more quickly through the try-out/-incheck-in process.

Camp: (Coach Feddersen)

Junior (Middle School – Tue-Wed, June 16-17, 1:00pm-5:00pm, Wheeler Arena, \$125- Coach Fedderson reminded parents and players that any middle school girl can attend the camp, and that it is not exclusive to girls on the middle school team.

High School – Fri-Sun, July 17-19 – Emory University, \$375 Coach Fedderson discussed this camp opportunity that includes skillbased training with college coaches including competitions and teambuilding experiences. No chaperones should be needed for this camp.

Fees / Fundraising: (Lisa Simpson)

\$400 / Player – Season Fee

(includes player pack items, equipment, referee fees, tournament fees, team meals, coaches, and more!)

\$375 / Player - Emory Team Camp - DUE by June 30th

\$200 Fundraising Minimum per player to help cover the total expense of \$800 per player per season.
