From the President

Dear Saline Area Soccer Families,

On behalf of SASA's Board of Directors, welcome to the spring soccer season! We're eager to get the season going for all of our players in Mini Kickers, Rec League and travel teams. I'm coaching my son's team (U14 Boys Gold) can't wait for the boys to play their first game this weekend!

As you may already know, we're in the process of developing our fields on Campus Parkway; the well and electric are completed and we'll be grading and irrigating after the spring season. If you have games or practices on that field (my team practices there), you'll notice that the terrain is pretty rough and improvements made possible by our CARES grant will make a huge difference beginning next season.

For this season, not too many changes. Same opportunities for our children to have fun playing soccer with new friends and old, same opportunities for Saline Area families to enjoy the games together, continued dedication from our volunteers and paid staff, continued focus on improving training opportunities and continued thankfulness to Saline Area Schools and York Township that provide the fields on which we play.

I'd like you to remember a few things as member families over the next couple of months for our outdoor season:

- While the spirit of the game gets away from us sometimes, we here solely for a safe, fun and developmental experience for our children. Winning is *merely interesting* in this context and in our Rec League, only a tie score is encouraged. Exemplary sportsmanship towards opponents and referees is expected from players, coaches and parents at all times in both travel and Rec games.
- We are guests on our fields. Saline Schools and York Township allow us the use of their fields and we're fortunate to have such nice and plentiful facilities. Please remember to be good guests by picking up your trash and never parking on the grass.
- Be thankful for our volunteers, they keep the club running. Our volunteer coaches, Board members, set-up and take-down helpers, team managers and parents give up their time to provide coaching and structure (finances, equipment purchase and maintenance, field maintenance, fundraising, league interactions, team placement... and the list goes on) for our teams so that members never have to worry about it.
- Volunteer. A small number within SASA serve many and those folks put in an awful lot of time for you...for free. With 800 players in SASA in any given season, we could really use the extra help, even if it's for support at single events. We are continually in need of people who are willing to help run our program in a variety of positions and we always need help with coaches, team parents and folks to help out with plenty of other activities. 
Campus Parkway Fundraiser!


