### Who are the Michigan Bucks?!?

The Michigan Bucks are Michigan's most successful soccer team in history and represent the highest level of soccer in the state. The Bucks enter their 18th sea- son in the United Soc-

Meet our new Travel Coaches! son in the United Soccer League's (USL) Premier Development League (PDL)

in May. Since the Bucks were formed in 1996 as the Mid Michigan Bucks based in Saginaw, the team holds over a dozen PDL records, including the team with most wins, playoff appearances, US Open Cup appearances and victories over professional teams (including their historic wins over Major League Soccer's New England Revolution in the 2000 US Open Cup and the Chicago Fire in 2012). The Bucks record CONCESSIONS of 17 consecutive winning seasons AVAILABLE! and incredible 15 playoff appearances (three PDL finals/three regular season

titles and one PDL championship) will probably never be matched. The Michigan Bucks are the minor league affiliate of the Columbus Crew of Major League Soccer.

SASA has the honor of hosting a Bucks game right here at Saline High School! They will be playing a Chicago Fire minor team.
