He represented the US on the U20 team at the 2009 World Cup in Egypt and captained the U17 and U18 US teams. He's also a leader off the field, with multiple academic achievement awards.

Saline Area Soccer Association travel teams offer athletes the opportunity to develop their soccer skills in a competitive regional league environment. SASA fields up to three travel teams per gender and age group. Teams start at the U8 age group for both boys and girls. The girls teams are called the Swarm and the boys teams are called the Sting. Within a gender and age group the teams are designated as the Black, Gold, or White. The Black team is the most competitive and the Gold is the next most competitive followed by the White team
