Message from Knox Cameron Director of Coaching and Player Development

Parents,

As some of you may know, there have been some recent developments from US Soccer regarding birth-year registrations and small sided/field size regulations. For the purposes of this communication, I will strictly focus on the birth-year changes.

US Soccer has mandated that the initiatives get implemented by August 2017. WSSL has mandated that the initiatives get implemented by August 2016. On November 4th, Sue and I will attend a meeting held by MSYSA to further the understanding of the mandate at a state level.

It is important to align the Club's philosophy with that of our governing body to ensure that our players understand the requirements of developing into the best soccer player he or she can become. Although SASA fully supports the US Soccer mandated changes and recognizes its long term benefits, we also understand that the changes in the short term will not only impact some teams but the changes will also impact specific players within the Club. There are a number of considerations in play including player skill levels, division of current teams and of course, player ages. These will all be considered as we analyze the current state of our rosters and implement various tactics moving forward.

Over the course of the next couple months, we **will be conducting an in-depth analysis** of each team and its respective players. After we have concluded this effort, I will meet with each team to discuss how the Club plans to move forward.

My ask is that you compile your questions and save them until we have the opportunity to meet with your respective teams. Please recognize that there is a lot to consider but the Club is committed to developing a strategy that best supports our players and their development.
