We are blessed with an active membership who pitches in to advance our programs, a group of talented staff and the generosity of both York Township and the Saline Area Schools for nice facilities.

I would be remiss if I didn't mention the recent rash of bad sportsmanship that has occurred during soccer games in Southeastern Michigan over the past few weeks. A youth referee was assaulted by an adult spectator a few weeks back and a game was stopped partway through for a referee to call for a police backup over the past week. While we have fortunately not experienced a similar level of ridiculous behavior in Saline, we must create and maintain an environment where both players and referees are safe from intimidation and violence. We'll be discussing it at our Board meeting on Sunday and working on ways to control and not tolerate this level of poor sportsmanship.

Message from Doug Schantz

I ask you to do two things to help:

- 1. Keep quiet. Your opinion on the referee calls are irrelevant to the game. Let the coaches deal with concerns over player safety if the referee isn't calling fouls appropriately. Bill Thiess, who was my mentor when I began coaching travel soccer about 15 years ago, used to hand out lollipops to the parents as a reminder to keep quiet.
- Remind other parents and spectators that inflammatory comments aren't helpful and, in fact, are contributing to the decline in the number of referees...people don't want to deal with disrespectful players, fans and coaches. Two of my children refereed and at least one quit because they were tired of the negativity.

PRE-TRAVEL TRYOUT TRAINING

In preparation for our Travel Tryouts on June 18th and 19th, SASA is holding **open pre-tryout training sessions** June 13-16th. Come and see if SASA travel is a good fit for your child! These sessions are an excellent opportunity to prepare your child for the upcoming tryouts.
