Note of Thanks from Saline FC Family

Two weekends ago, we had one of the best soccer weekends as a family. All three of our children were lucky enough to play on teams that made it to the Championship games at Abby's Cup Tournament and each won their final games in nail biter finishes. We sat on the sidelines of more than a dozen games that weekend and cheered on many of the Saline FC teams that were competing that day, enjoying the company of other parents and teammates. We went home excited for the kids and their teams and totally exhausted. By the next morning, our entire lives had changed. A middle of the night fire that started in our attic destroyed our house that night and the realization sunk in very quickly as we waited for the fire trucks to arrive that we were very lucky to escape the house unhurt. Although the fire took most of our worldly possessions, we had gotten out of the house with the only things that really mattered.

The point of this piece is really not about that night, but about the days and weeks afterwards and the reason why Rob and I wanted to share our story in this forum. Word of the fire spread amazingly quickly through our soccer teams. By Monday morning we had received phone calls, messages of concern and offers of help from so many of our sideline pals. In the weeks since, we have been blown away by how quickly and selflessly our teams (both old and new) and the club itself mobilized to help us out; before we even knew what we would need, it was provided to us. We have received support in the form of kind words of concern, offers of rides and childcare, new and donated clothing, dinners, gift cards, replacement uniforms, the list goes on. We are so incredibly grateful for all of the help that we received.

My own family never participated in team sports growing up (apart from one disastrous season in "lassie league"), so my involvement as a parent in youth sports has been a learning experience for me. I have developed a deep appreciation for the tangible and intangible benefits of youth soccer. There are, of course, the things we all enjoy: watching the kids play and develop, seeing how the teams learn to celebrate their triumphs and comfort each other during disappointment. There are the well-advertised lessons of sportsmanship, teamwork, respect for teammates and coaches, mental and physical toughness and dedication that can only be taught and learned in this venue. Parents and coaches make an enormous investment by contributing so much of their own time and energy to the sport. But, what I think it took this life-changing event to make us realize, is that we have created an amazing community around this club and our teams. We've all seen this community at work in somewhat smaller ways by families providing shared rides to practices and games, bringing group size coffee and hot chocolate for early morning games, sharing umbrellas during a downpour or blankets during a freezing late fall game and contributing time and money for end of season gifts and parties. What we found truly remarkable, however, was the realization that this community extends well beyond the soccer fields and creates a safety net that was invisible until it was really needed.

We are now settled in a rental home while we wait for our house to be rebuilt. The kid's drawers are filled with donated and new clothing. Our fridge is filled with food from the meal train that our teams kindly insisted on setting up. The fire is becoming more of a memory now but the lessons of generosity, selflessness, friendship and support that the kids and we have received from will never be forgotten.

BY-LAW CHANGE

Doug Schantz, President - Saline FC

Please join your fellow Saline FC members at our bowling party and annual meeting on October 30 at 1:30 pm. This is an opportunity for our members to hear about the state of our club and elect officers for the coming year.

The following change to our club's bylaws is being proposed to address two changes in the composition of our Board of Directors:

- 1. Division of responsibilities for Fields and Equipment, formerly both the responsibility of one director and
- 2. Combination of responsibilities within the Travel division, a change in the bylaws that reflects actual practice for the past several years."

Proposed By-Law Changes: Section V, subsection a

- ii) <u>Director of Fields:</u> Shall be responsible for field procurement, organization and development of fields, and marking and maintenance of fields, and perform other duties as directed by the Board.
- iii) <u>Director of Equipment:</u> Shall be responsible for all equipment (goals, nets, coach bags and contents, balls, etc.), and shall meet, solicit, and take bids for equipment, inspect equipment, receive, distribute, and collect equipment at the end of each season, and make equipment recommendations to the Board, and perform other duties as directed by the Board.
- iv) Community Relations: (change from iii to iv)
- v) <u>Director of Travel Program:</u> Shall be responsible for the direction of the travel program, may serve as the chair of the Travel Committee, schedules fields for practices in cooperation with Director or Recreation, coordinates tryouts and establishes the travel calendar. The Director of Travel Program is responsible for coordinating the travel coach application process and ensures that advertisements for try-outs are appropriately placed for try-outs and coach applications. Director of Travel Program is also responsible for player, coach and manager registration, coach evaluations, game scheduling with travel leagues, and participates in any risk management investigation involving travel players, coaches or parents and is the SASA representative to the travel leagues.
