Why I Need a “Team Parent”

During the course of the upcoming season, I will perform many duties as your Team Manager. With the assistance of my coaches, my most important responsibilities include teaching your child how to improve their playing, how to work with a team, and how to enjoy the game of baseball.

There are several other administrative functions that must be performed by our team that can take valuable time away from the coaching staff's main duties. In order to insure that our time is best spent for the players, it is part of my responsibility to appoint an official “Team Parent”.

Our Team Parent must be a responsible person who can provide a small amount of time to help our team run smoothly. The duties of our Team Parent include the following:

- Disseminate league information to our players as the need arises.
- Provide the photo information, assist our team during photo taking time on Opening Day, collect photo envelopes and funds, and hand out photos later in the season.
- Encourage our team to maximize participation in the Bat-A-Thon fundraiser. Remind our team players to collect their pledges prior to Opening Day. Collect the pledge sheets during our turn at the Bat-A-Thon, and assist in proper paperwork at the fundraiser for our team. Collect funds raised by our players and in turn provide them to our Division Administrator.
- Assist our team with other Opening Day activities.
- Collect our team players' All Star Ballots (in applicable divisions) and provide them to our Division Administrator.
- Help keep our parents and players informed as the need arises.
