Meeting Minutes

These minutes reflect the Regular Monthly Meeting held at 5:00 pm on Sunday, October 27th, 2025 at the Memorial Building in Portales NM.

League President Brian Cox called the meeting to order at 5:05 pm. Members in attendance were: Brian Cox, Sara Cox, Chris Valdez, Trindy Valdez, Danny Nunez, & Francine Jimenez. Guests present were: Ed Dean, Stephanie Dean, and Austin Beckermeyer.

Old Business:

1. Brian opened the floor for nominations for:
 - a. Umpire in Chief:
 - i. Chris nominated Austin for Umpire in Chief, Sara seconded the motion. Vote was unanimous.
 - b. Baseball Player Agent:
 - i. Sara nominated Ed for Baseball Player Agent, Francine seconded. Vote was unanimous.
 - c. Member at Large:
 - i. Francine nominated Stephanie for Member at Large, Danny seconded. Vote was unanimous.

New Business:

1. Dates for the 2026 season were discussed and decided on as follows:
 - a. Opening Day: March 28th
 - b. League-Wide Field Clean Up Day: March 21st
 - c. Coaches Meetings: March 5th (Minor/Major), March 6th (T-Ball/Coach Pitch)
 - d. Tryouts: March 1st (ALL divisions), March 2nd (SB), March 3rd (BB)
 - e. In-Person Registration Dates: Jan. 24th, Feb. 7th, Feb. 18th
 - f. Online Registration: Jan 1st – Feb. 20th
2. Divisions Offered:
 - a. It was discussed and voted on to offer and open registration for the same divisions as last year, including Junior and Senior baseball and softball.
3. Registration Prices:
 - a. Prices will stay the same as last year, \$70 for Minor/Major/Junior/Senior and \$60 for T-ball/Coach Pitch
4. Suggested Changes to current RCLL By-Laws:
 - a. Sara presented adding rules to the current By-Laws that would change the way T-Ball and Coach Pitch is currently played. She handed out a copy of the rules she would like to see enforced, and encouraged board members to read them and bring any changes/input they have to the next meeting.
 - b. Brian discussed changes he would like to see in the way All Star funds and jerseys are handled. He would like the board to choose a nice, affordable jersey that represents our league that all All Star teams would be required to wear to

district and state tournaments. He would also like to change the current by-laws to where all AllStar funds are put into one fund, and AllStar teams may fundraise when needed, and draw from it when needed. He is going to type up a draft of these rules to present at the next meeting and we will vote on those changes then.
