

# Roosevelt County Little League

## Meeting Minutes

These minutes reflect the Regular Monthly Meeting held at 2:00 pm on Sunday, February 1st, 2026 at the Memorial Building in Portales NM.

League President Brian Cox called the meeting to order at 2:01 pm. Members in attendance were: Brian Cox, Sara Cox, Chris Valdez, Trindy Valdez, and Danny Nunez.. Members absent were: Francine Jimenez, Jerrod Strange, Pete Boyd, Stephanie Dean, Jennifer Saiz, Ed Dean, and Austin Beckermeyer

Treasurer's Report: Trindy noted that a deposit from sign sponsors was made and All-Star moneys had been moved into savings-noted on her spreadsheet.

### Old Business:

1. Sign Sponsors: Members were given an updated list of sign sponsors with about 20 still needing to turn money in.
2. Members in attendance were given a coupon code for free registration. Registration closes on February 20<sup>th</sup>.
3. There were 114 total registrations as of meeting time.

### New Business:

1. Approve/Deny Parent's request to keep son (9) in Coach Pitch.
  - i. Brian read an email written by a parent wishing to keep her special needs son in Coach Pitch, even though he is league age 9. A short discussion followed.
  - ii. Vote was unanimous to allow child to "play down" in Coach Pitch.
2. Approve/Deny Painting of Ball at Complex.
  - i. Elizabeth Shelton has given a quote on repainting/stenciling ball. Will also need City's approval. Brian presented a quote of \$75 to get the ball painted, with materials possibly donated by Ace Hardware.
  - ii. Vote was unanimous to pay Elizabeth Shelton to paint the ball, waiting on approval from the City.
3. Date for sorting equipment/making coach's bags: Board Members will meet on February 21<sup>st</sup> at 1:30pm at the Complex to sort equipment and make coach's bags.
4. Fundraising
  - i. Items for raffle: Brian has secured a ¼ beef for a prize, and also another gun. 3<sup>rd</sup> prize will be a bogg bag filled with gear.
  - ii. Ticket price: \$5/5 for \$20
5. Opening Day Details
  - i. Announcer: Don Thomas has agreed
  - ii. Photographer: Donita/Times Remembered has agreed

- iii. National Anthem:
  - iv. Little League Pledge: Members were encouraged to think about 1 softball player and 1 baseball player to recite the pledge.
  - v. First Pitch: We will ask Mike Davidson and Gary Watkins
  - vi. 2025 Junior Division District Champions will also be recognized.
6. End of season tournament
- i. Brian proposed the idea of scheduling an end of season tournament for the upper division. It would be double-elimination, so each team would be guaranteed two games. We could then schedule only 10 regular season games and still meet the 12-game minimum. Bracket seeding will be determined by draft order.
  - ii. Vote was unanimous on holding an end of season tournament.
