HYR Futsal Rule Card

General Rules:

Teams have 4 outfield players and one goalie. The goalie must wear a different color jersey. There are NO offsides. Substitutions happen on the fly and do not require stoppages.

Fouls and Misconduct:

No high kicks. No slide tackles. No impeding the goalie when they have possession of the ball.

Kickoffs:

The ball can go backwards or forward from kickoff. No goals can be scored from kickoff without hitting another player.

Kickins:

When the ball goes out of bounds across the sideline last touched by one team, the ball is kicked in by the opposing team. The ball must be placed on or right behind the sideline. The opposing team must give 15 feet of space to the kicker. Kickins can't go directly into the goal without being touched. If a kickin goes into the opponent's goal without being touched, the goalie is awarded the ball for a goal clearance.

Corner Kicks:

Are taken when the ball wholly crosses the goal line last touched by the defensive team. The ball must be placed on the corner spot and played in by the attacking team.

Free Kicks:

Are awarded for a foul by the opposing team. The ball must be stopped completely before it's taken. The ball can be kicked directly into the goal. The opposing team must give 15 feet to the kicker.

Penalty Kicks:

Are awarded for a foul in the penalty area. They are a direct shot from one attacker against the goalie. All other players must stand outside the area until the ball is kicked. The attacker can't touch the ball again until it's touched by another player. The ball is kicked from 18 feet away.

Goal Clearances:

Are taken by the opposing team when the ball wholly crosses the goal line last touched from the other team. The goalkeeper must roll or throw the ball out but can not be in the air past the halfway line.
