Introduction/Scope

Palm Harbor Little league (PHLL) requires team Managers to maintain a “player position log” for each game played. The log will detail every player’s position(s) and playing time to ensure the wellbeing of the league.

The “player position log” must be made available for review if requested by any PHLL board officer for each completed game in a season.

Use of this Player Position Log process is subject to change by the league’s Player Agent and Board of Director Officers as outlined in the PHLL Constitution and/or PHLL by laws.

Objective

The objective of the PHLL Player Position Log is to help:

- Team managers manage to the PHLL minimum play standards throughout the season.
- Provide a record of a player participation should a parent have concerns about where a player plays and how much playing time a player receives.
- PHLL evaluate Team Managers execution of the requirements of player minimum play rules for the division they are assigned.

Process

Before a PHLL game commences, each PHLL team is required to complete a Player Position Log form for their own team. Each team will enter:

Fielding Position Section of Log:

- The game details at the top of the form. (Team name, Opponents Name, Field location, Date of game, etc.)
- Game roster including each player’s uniform number, first and last name, and league age
- For each inning, the players playing position is recorded on the log in the appropriate inning column. (P, C, 1B, 2B, 3B, SS, LF, CF, RF, X) Note: Multiple positions may be entered in an inning if player positions are switched during an inning.

Pitching Section of Log: (The Pitching Log is only used for AA Divisions or higher)

- Enter the player uniform number for each player that pitches.

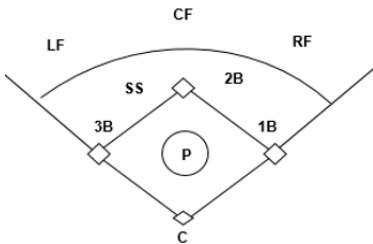
