

Parkway Little League Refund Policy

Updated September 1, 2021

Parkway Little League strives to provide the best youth baseball experience for the Parkway community. This requires year-round preparation and advance planning, including purchasing uniforms and equipment, establishing teams, building rosters and schedules, and training and verifying coaches in each division. Each Spring, the deadline for open registration is set for late February in order to ensure that all of these steps can be accomplished by opening day in April.

During the spring and summer of 2020, the league proved that it can continue to organize and run a very safe, top-notch experience despite the Covid-19 pandemic. However, the cancellations that occurred late that spring demonstrated the need for a refund policy that reflects the risk of such a future situation to the league. As Parkway Little League is a community not-for-profit, the Board of Directors have instituted a refund policy that aims to be as flexible and family-friendly as possible, while also protecting the league for future generations.

Once the open registration period starts, player registrations may later be cancelled and refunded in full (less the \$3 transaction fee imposed by the payment vendor) until the open registration period later closes. Once open registration closes and the late registration period begins (typically in late February for the Spring season), no further refunds will be issued for that season. This includes if the season is subsequently shortened or cancelled due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

If a family is experiencing an economic hardship or otherwise feels that their circumstances warrant a refund, the board's finance committee will consider these on a case-by-case basis.
