Parkway Little League All-Star Manager Selection Process

Selection of the All-Star Manager Nomination Committee

Each season, five members of the Parkway Little League board of directors shall serve as the All-Star Manager Nomination Committee for all District All-Star teams. These teams include the Williamsport Tournament (12U), the 11U District All-Star, and the 10U District All-Stars.

The Committee will consist of the PLL Majors General Manager, the Commissioner of PLL and the PLL Summer Coordinator. The remaining two spots will be PLL Board Members in good standing elected by a vote of the entire board.

Before the April PLL board meeting, board members in good standing should declare their interest via email to the Majors General Manager to be included on the ballot for the All-Star Manager Nomination Committee.

These two positions will be elected by anonymous vote of the members in attendance at the April Board meeting. No proxy, phone call, or electronic votes may be cast. Each member who has declared interest, if wishing to do so, will get to speak at the meeting prior to the vote about his or her qualifications for the committee. All members will cast two votes, and the two members who receive the two highest vote totals will be elected to the committee. In the event of a tie, there will be a second vote held where all board members will cast one vote between the tied members to break the tie.

Once elected, it is the duty and requirement of all five board members to review all resumes of the potential All-Star Managers and make a fair and just recommendation to the entire board for managers of all three Parkway District All-Star Teams.

The following criteria should be used for selection of Manager:

- Must be a Parkway Majors Manager or Coach (not a scorekeeper) during the current season.
- Baseball Coaching Experience including Parkway Major, All-Star, or Travel Teams
- Other relevant baseball experience
- Ability to lead the children of the team and represent the Parkway community and Parkway Little League in a manner consistent with the values of sportsmanship and tradition of excellence.

Process for Selecting All-Star Managers and Coaches

- 1. All coaches interested in becoming a PLL District All-Star Manager must submit an email to the parkwaylittleleagueboston@gmail.com (Subject line: DISTRICT ALL-STAR Manager) by April 30th of each year.
- 2. The email must include:
 - a. Name
 - b. District all-star team for which you are applying to manage
 - c. If not chosen, would your second choice be to be a coach on the above team or would you wish to apply to manage another team
 - d. Current team/current coaching position
 - e. All relevant baseball coaching experience
 - f. Any additional relevant baseball experience
 - g. A statement of why you are best served to manage a team that represents Parkway Little League in the District Tournament
- 3. The All-Star Manager Nomination Committee will meet to review all coaching resumes before the May PLL Board Meeting. If a committee member has declared interest in being a manager or is interested in being a coach of a particular age group, the member must recuse themselves from that particular selection process.
- 4. At the May PLL Board meeting, the All-Star Manager Nomination Committee will present their recommendations of an all-star manager for each of the three District Teams to the board.
- 5. The Board will vote by a majority of those in attendance to approve or disapprove each selection individually. No proxy, phone call, or electronic votes may be cast. If the board disapproves of a recommendation, the Committee will present other potential managers until there is an approved manager for each team named at the May Board meeting.
- 6. Upon selection, the new District All-Star Managers will be notified by the Majors General Manager.
- 7. The District All-Star Manager has the option to take the Travel A team of the same age group. This manager should notify the Summer Coordinator of his intent within one week of his selection as Manager.
- 8. The District All-Star Manager will send his selection of (2) assistant coaches to the Majors General Manager on or before the All-Star Selection night in May/June. By Little League rule, all prospective coaches of All-Star teams 10-12 must be listed and approved major league coaches or managers (not scorekeepers)
