### **Team Parent Duties**

- Communicate key information to your team
- Help managers & coaches delegate tasks to team families
- Orient team families to the Game Changer app
- Promote league fundraising activities
- Help coordinate scorekeeping & pitch count duties
- Coordinate spirit wear, team banner, souvenirs, team party and manager/coach gifts

### **Volunteers must be background checked & Fingerprinted**

- Login to Sports Connect and register as the Team Parent Volunteer
- You'll received an e-mail to start the background check process
- Fingerprints ARE required this year – will be done during Hit-A-Thon
- Volunteers may require additional [Mandated Reporter training](#)

### **Uniforms & Equipment**

- League will provide jersey, hat
- Play It Again Voucher includes: pants, belt, socks, and under shirt
- Parents will provide glove and cleats
- Each player will also need their own helmet and USA approved bat; no shared equipment. Items can be borrowed from the league if family cannot provide them.

### Game Day | Team Responsibilities:

- HOME Team (along third base line)
  - Field Prep
  - Official Scorekeeping (AA division thru 50/70): GameChanger App
- VISITING Team (along first base line)
  - Announcing
  - Field Break Down & locking bathrooms during weekdays or if last team on Saturday.

### Scorekeeping (Divisions AA thru 50/70)

- Game Changer app has scorekeeping & pitch count functions; Refer designated volunteers to their [training](#). GameChanger is the Official Scorekeeping book.
- Scoreboard operator can also be the Announcer.
- Recommend a maximum of 2 people in the Announcer/Scoreboard shed. Children not be permitted.

### CPR Certification/First Aid
