### Stadium Use and Field Set Up Guidelines 2021

#### Practices and Games

**(First coach will need to get keys from Reid's mailbox [REDACTED] to open the stadium. Keys will need to be handed off to each successive incoming coach. The last coach will return them to Reid's.)**

#### Opening and Pre-Game

1. **Open at 11/11:30am**, as often there will be people waiting to enter even that early if noon game. Or, may already be open due to football.
2. Always **unlock parking gates** first and encourage visiting teams to please park in the lot.
3. IF needed, Move/put the **benches** in place (may be on the other side in the fall because of football).
4. **IF NEEDED, IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OUTGOING COACH TO SET UP NETS AND FIELD FOR THE FOLLOWING GAME IF CHANGES ARE NEEDED SO THE ARRIVING COACH CAN PREPARE FOR THE GAME.**

#### U10 – 53 1/3x60

- Use the football lines for width; place the goals on each **20-yard line**.
- For a penalty box use yellow discs and place them at the **30-yard line for length** and on each hash mark for width.

#### U11/12 – 53 1/3x70

- Use football lines for width; place the goals on each **15-yard line**.
- For a penalty box use yellow discs and place them at the **30-yard line** and on the inside of the numbers for width.

#### Closing & Post-Game

1. Teams must **clean up the sidelines** of any trash water bottles at the end of their game- this includes **between games.**
2. If Needed, Return small **goals** to the far end of the stadium.
3. **Lock** the Hillsdale Ave. gate and lock the parking gates.
4. Email - Craig and Reid if any **balls or other equipment is lost** or needed - including 1st aid items.
5. RETURN the keys to Reid's mailbox.
