WE SENT TWO (2) PEOPLE TO THE WEST TEXAS FIRE CONFERENCE IN DECEMBER AND FOUR (4) PEOPLE TO TEXAS A & M FIRE SCHOOL IN JULY. WE CONTINUE TO MEET EVERY 2ND AND 4TH WEDNESDAY OF EACH MONTH FOR MEETINGS AND TRAINING. WE CONTINUE TO UPGRADE OUR STRUCTURE BUNKER GEAR AND WILDLAND FIREFIGHTING GEAR TO HELP KEEP OUR FIREFIGHTERS SAFE WHEN FIGHTING THESE FIRES. THIS OCTOBER WE WILL BE RECEIVING OUR NEW, MODERN RESCUE TRUCK. ALL OF THIS AND MORE IS DONE WITH THE HELP OF YOUR SUPPORT.
