The meeting was called to order at 4:21pm by James Craft, President.

- **1.** Approval of Minutes: Ray Aitkin made a motion to approve the minutes from our last meeting. Josh seconded that motion. The motion carried unanimously.
- **2.** Financial Report: Sara noted that we needed all the fundraising money in asap. We paid a bill to DW Electric and to Texas Multi-Chem which would wipe us out. The medals for Closing Day were bought as well. Ray made a motion to approve the financial report. Paul seconded that motion. The motion carried unanimously.
- 3. Tournament Site: The possibility of hosting minors and softball tournaments was discussed. As of now the District Tournament was set for June 20th and the AAA for June 15th. Everyone agreed on wanting to be a host for tournaments. It was noted that someone confirmed that Jellystone would give discounts to teams coming in for tournaments.

Ingram Little League Special Board Meeting Sunday May 15, 2019 at 6:00pm Ingram Ballpark

The meeting was called to order at 5:59pm by James Craft, President.

Board Members in attendance: Ray Aitkin, James Craft, Paul Simone, Elizabeth Olson, Scott Lewis, Daniel Gonzalez, Josh Craft, Brian Hensley and Lyndsie Smith

1. Review of Fields Upgrade: James noted the purpose of this meeting was informational to inform the board members of the recent history of field improvements and to provide the layout and plan for future field improvements. Several pages of detailed plans and budgets were provided to each board member.

Each field was reviewed. Regarding Field 1 improvements the note was made that the \$1000.00 to cut ridges off grass edges of skinned area would be free.

Ray questioned the \$780.00 on Field 1 improvements for Diamond Dandy Sand and wanted to know how much sand that would be. James responded that it would take 3-4 tons.

Brian brought up the discussion that he had wanted to donate all of the dirt to fill in Field 1 and 3. He also noted he was told to move forward and handle this and then was later told by the dirt company he could not do that. James brought up the obstacle that the issue was we could not use the tax exempt status of the organization to have someone pay for the dirt. Brian agreed to pay for the dirt without the tax exempt option. James also noted that several rain days had caused him to not want the dirt delivered. The majority of the board agreed that the donation was good. James suggested the dirt then be delivered after closing day to not interfere with closing games and ceremonies. He also said to please coordinate all deliveries with Josh. Josh agreed to call and schedule delivery potentially for Friday.

Ray noted that Claude Jordan would be willing to donate his time and dethatcher to rake the dirt. Josh also mentioned that Texas Multi Chem was also planning on using their super rake in August to do this for free.

There was also discussion about putting the sod in. Elizabeth mentioned getting a quote on the sod to compare with the quote from Texas Multi Chem and the best option could be evaluated.

A motion was made by Elizabeth to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Ray. The meeting adjourned at 6:34pm.
