[Annual Registration] is due and payable directly to CSC at time of accepting an offered position on a team. For PDP, Annual Registration is payable once per season at time of registering the player for the first segment chosen.

[Annual CSC Dues] are due and payable directly to CSC for the season. CSC Dues are permitted to be paid in a lump sum at the start of the season *or* in monthly installments. If paying in installments, payments are invoiced on the 1st of each month and are due by the 10th of each month. A \$25 late fee will be assessed on payments not received by the 15th of each month. Payments that are 30 days in arrears will result in suspension from all CSC activities.

[Team Fees] are due monthly and are payable directly to the Team Manager to cover team expenses, such as costs of games, tournaments, coach travel expenses. Team Managers set fees and communicate amounts and payment methods directly to their team.

[Season Start Dates] BOYS: U7 thru U19 Boys begin in August // GIRLS: U7 thru U14 Girls begin in August. U15 thru U19 Girls begin in November.
