Registration

Team check-in will take place on June 26 from 4:00pm at Witter Field. Team managers are required to report with the following: tournament affidavit, proof of residency forms, and medical releases.

Opening Ceremonies

Opening Ceremonies will take place on Thursday, June 26 at 6pm at Witter Field. Players wear jerseys and hats/visors, but shorts and sneakers are fine. Teams bring banners. Teams will be announced by division (Juniors, followed by Seniors), followed by a brief opening ceremony. Pin trading to follow.

Managers, Coaches and Umpires Meeting

A Pre-Tournament Meeting will be held right after Opening Ceremonies at a location to be determined. All tournament officials, umpires, managers, and coaches are required to attend.

Managers – please bring your team tournament binder/book, including your affidavit. Your league's boundary map, affidavit, proof of residency/school enrollment forms, player waivers, medical releases, plus certificates for managers and coaches will be re-certified. This is required for your team's participation in the tournament and must be turned in at this meeting. Your books will be held throughout the tournament until your team is eliminated...or until you win it all!

Playing and Practice Fields

Admission/Parking Fees

There is no Admission or Parking Fees. Please note: Parking immediately adjacent to the field can be limited. The parking lot is a 5 minute walk to the field. You can drop off to the field and then find parking.

Spectator Policies and Procedures

Bleacher seating is available, but feel free to bring lawn chairs.

NO pets are permitted at the Alexandria Little League facilities.

NO noise makers of any kind may be used.

Music will NOT be permitted except as provided by the press box. (Including walk-up music played by individual teams)

Tobacco and alcoholic beverages are NOT permitted.

No equipment associated with parental streaming of games may be affixed to any location on the playing facility including light stanchions and fencing. If a parent wishes to stream a game, it must be viewed through a personal social media account for private use only and may not be on the open internet.

Game Procedures/Guidelines

Teams should be at the field no earlier than 1 hour prior to their assigned game time. Home and visitors will be determined by a coin toss at the PreTournament Meeting. The home and visitor for all single elimination finals games will be determined by coin flip at the field when teams arrive. The home team will occupy the first base dugout and the visiting team will occupy the third base dugout.

All 2025 Little League International Tournament Rules for Jrs and Srs Levels will be used throughout the tournament, without exception.

Concession Information

Gatorade and water available throughout the tournament. Cash and credit/debit cards (including Apple Pay and Venmo) are accepted. The area around Witter Field includes many fast food and restaurant options, as well as grocery stores.

Game Information

The District 4 website and District Facebook page will post score and schedule updates during the tournament.

Team Equipment

Each team is responsible for providing its own equipment approved for Little League Softball play. If the need arises, Alexandria Little League may be able to loan equipment to a team in case of an emergency.

Umpires will inspect all equipment under the same guidelines as the district tournaments.
