## Tournament Details

Entry fee is $\$ 400$ per team, $\$ 325$ for 8 U . Includes umpires, game balls, and trophies for $1^{\text {st }}$ $\& 2^{\text {nd }}$ place. No gate charge. $50 \%$ off 2 nd tournament if entering both tournaments.

Details:

- This tournament is community based.
- This is an open bats tournament.
- Teams must provide their own insurance.
- Birth date cut off is player's age on April 29th.
- Birth certificates must be available in the event of a protest. If a manager cannot produce a player's $B C$ upon request, the team will forfeit that game and player will remain ineligible until a $B C$ is produced. Pictures are acceptable, as long as they are legible. Any illegible copies will be considered unacceptable.
- Little League Rules will apply, except where noted differently below.
- Players' jerseys do not have to be identical but must have a number.
- Weather Cancellation Policy:
- 0 games played = Full Refund
- 1 game played = $\$ 150$ refund ( $8 \mathrm{U} \$ 100$ )
- 2 games played = No refund (we commit to doing anything possible to play!)
- Refund Policy if team backs out prior to tournament: $100 \%$ refund if prior to April $1^{\text {st }}$ for Early Bird, June $1^{\text {st }}$ for Dave D.

1. Stealing (9U-11U) is permitted after the "pitch reaches the batter"

## Tournament Structure:

1. Tournament Director: Matt Koneval (440) 667-1560 konevama@hotmail.com, Assistant: Bryan Rush (330) 571-0763; bryanrush75@sbcglobal.net
2. All teams must be ready to begin play 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start time.
3. Teams may play with a minimum of 8 players, maximum of 14 . If a player shows after first pitch, he may enter the game, but must be added to the bottom of the batting order.
4. Home/Visitor by coin flip in pool play. In bracket play, the higher seed is the Home team.
5. Home team is the official scorer. Scorekeepers need to confirm score every inning.
6. Winning team must report final score to the Tournament Director (text to 440-667-1560).
7. Game warms ups are permitted in the outfield and foul territory only.
8. No hit sticks outside of the fences. All kids with a bat must have a helmet on.
9. Time limits are as follows:

- Pool games will have a 1 hour 45 minutes time limit. No inning shall start after 1 hour 45 minutes. Once started, the inning must finish. New innings starts when the last out is made of the previous inning. Pool games can end in a tie.
- Playoff (bracket) games: 1 hour 45 minutes time limit. No inning shall start after 1 hour 45 minutes. Once started, the inning must finish. New innings starts when the last out is made of the previous inning. If a tie after 1 hour 45 minutes, or 6 innings, whichever comes first, a shootout will start. Shootout innings will start with the last batter on $2^{\text {nd }}$ base and a count of 3 balls and 2 strikes for each batter, 0 outs.
- Championship game will not have a time limit.

10. Pool play consists of 2 games. Pool record will determine seeding.
11. Bracket seeding will be determined in this order:

- W-L record
- Head-to-Head
- Highest run differential (Max of 10 runs per game to discourage running up a score)
- and if still needed, a Coin Flip

12. Any player, Coach, or Fan ejected from the game will NOT be permitted to be present at the team's next game. This is non-negotiable. If player, Coach, or Fan is found on premise after being ejected, then that team will be forced to forfeit that game.

## Pitching Restrictions:

3 innings per game. 6 innings per day. 9 innings per tournament.

1. Pitcher may return to the mound during a game if he has not pitched his 3 innings.
2. Balks only in play for 12 U .
3. One pitch in an inning $=1$ inning pitched. (no $1 / 3$ innings).
4. Manager/Coach must initial opposing teams Pitcher's log - which must indicate who pitched and number of innings pitched.
5. Pitcher must be removed for the game if he hits 3 batters.
6. Manager/Coach mound visits allowed. 1 per inning. The pitcher must be removed on the $2^{\text {nd }}$ visit.

## Rules of Play:

1. Little League Rules will apply, except where noted differently.
2. $9 \mathrm{U}-11 \mathrm{U}$ will be played $46 / 60$ pitching and base distances.
3. Maximum of 14 on roster
4. Roster batting in a continuous order.
5. Minimum Playing Time: 2 defensive innings/game, unless game is ended due to mercy rule.
6. Pitchers: 3 innings/game, 6/day, 9/tournament.
7. Courtesy runner for catcher is allowed with 2 outs. Runner must be the last player that was "out".
8. Dropped $3^{\text {rd }}$ strike will be in effect for 11 U and 12 U . No dropped $3^{\text {rd }}$ strike for $8 \mathrm{U}, 9 \mathrm{U} \& 10 \mathrm{U}$.
9. No leadoff/stealing until the ball reaches the plate in 46/60 games.
10. If player leaves early: $1^{\text {st }}$ offense $=$ Team warning. $2^{\text {nd }}=$ runner is out.
11. Base runners can score on passed ball/wild pitch (expect for 8 U ).
12. Bat Restrictions: all bats are acceptable.
13. No run limit per inning in $9 \mathrm{U}, 10 \mathrm{U}, 11 \mathrm{U}, 12 \mathrm{U}$ and 13 U . 8 U is 5 runs per inning.
14. Mercy Rule: 15 runs after 3 innings; 10 after 4,8 after 5
15. Player Injury: If a player is injured and unable to bat the remainder of the game, then he will be skipped in the batting order without being considered an out.
16. Protest Fee: $\$ 100$ cash, paid at time of protest. Protest must be filed prior to next pitch.
17. Tournament Director will be judge of final decision. If Tournament Director is unavailable, then succession will be as follows: CFLLN LL President, VP, or Field Manager.
18. In case of rain shortened game: Games deemed official after $21 / 2$ innings of play, if home team winning, 3 innings if home team losing. Tie is an option in pool play in this scenario.
19. Bracket play is single elimination.

## 8U Modified Rules of Play:

1. 10 fielders permitted. 4 outfielders required (unless less than 10 players); outfielders must be in the grass.
2. A maximum of 5 runs per inning will be scored.
