



Tee Ball Rules 2022

1. Home team shall use the 1st base dugout and visiting team the 3rd base dugout.
2. Each player must be given 2 innings in the infield per game. Ideally, each player should also play at least 1 inning in the outfield.
3. No player sits twice before everyone has sat once (per game).
4. Game shall not exceed 60 minutes in length.
5. Time Limit - No new inning can start after 45 minutes.
6. No Run Limit - The inning is over when the offensive team bats through the entire lineup.
7. Players hit off tee only (no coach pitch) until Saturday April 9th, 2022.
8. Coach Pitch may begin Saturday April 9th 2022. Each player gets a maximum of 3 pitches from the coach. If the ball is not put into play, the tee is used. No strikeouts or walks.
9. Manager should be the “coach” pitching to the kids. If the manager is unable to throw, then a substitute coach can pitch (league approved volunteer).
10. Batter and baserunners have the opportunity to advance a maximum of 1 base, except for the last batter who clears the bases and goes all the way around for a home run.
11. There may be 10 players in the field on defense (4 outfielders, one pitcher, one catcher). No second pitcher allowed (this takes away opportunity from the other infielders)
12. Hitting team must maintain a continuous batting order. Latecomers will be added to the bottom of the lineup.
13. Managers are responsible for controlling the conduct of their players, coaches and fans. A code of conduct has been signed by each family and must be adhered to. If there are any issues, the offender will be asked to leave the field.
14. Field prep and cleanup - Both teams are responsible for grooming, field preparation and clean up (including dugouts).
 - Home team is responsible for set-up (dragging field, chalking and putting out the bases).
 - Visiting team is responsible for clean up (dragging field, watering and putting away the bases if they are the last game of the day).
