Local Rotation Rule:

EVERY PLAYER MUST PLAY A MINIMUM OF TWO INNINGS IN THE INFIELD EVERY GAME

ENCOURAGED FOR INTERLEAGUE PLAY AS WELL

*Minors by the 4th inning, Majors by the 5th inning.

NO PLAYER SITS TWICE BEFORE EACH PLAYER HAS SAT ONCE.

*Except (Majors only): If the starting pitcher is still on the mound, they can continue pitching and another player can be sat twice (before the pitcher). As soon as the pitcher is removed from the game, they must sit the bench. If a full game is thrown, that pitcher must sit the bench the first inning of the next game.

LL Run Rule 4.00: 15 after 3 inn; 10 after 4 inn; 8 after 5 inn

Pitching Rules:

*Any pitcher who throws 41 or more pitches in a game cannot catch in that same game (reverting back applies).

**Any catcher who catches four or more innings in a game cannot pitch in that calendar day.

*** Any catcher who catches three innings or less may pitch but cannot exceed 21 pitches or more in that game and return to catcher. The pitcher can continue to pitch per pitch count allowance per day. ****Pitcher can finish the current batter when they reach their pitch count maximum. *****Players may not pitch in more than one game in a day (majors doubleheader)

*****Pitchers may complete pitching to a batter when they reach their pitch count maximum and revert back to the pitch count at the start. of the at bat for the days rest determination.
