

Dear CVLL Parents and Players,

Canyon View Little League (CVLL) is preparing to select players for the All-Star Season. All players who are interested in being considered for selection to any of the CVLL post season tournament teams shall submit this form to the All-Star Committee at allstars@canyonviewll.org. Players will be selected based on playing ability, eligibility, availability, and commitment to the team. Our goal is to provide a competitive, positive, and development-focused experience for all players. It is important that you review and discuss this form, as well as the Canyon View All-Star Document on our website, with your player before submittal.

Attendance Requirements: CVLL All-Star teams will play in very competitive tournaments. This level of play requires our teams to work very hard to maximize talents and be competitive. Consequently, the teams will plan on practicing daily in the weeks prior to the tournaments. This is an immense commitment and the players are required to make this team their priority. Failure to meet attendance expectations may impact a player's role or status on the team, at the discretion of the Manager and league leadership. This means overnight sports camps, family vacations, and other conflicting sports teams should be postponed until the completion of All-Star season baseball and softball tournaments. Only the League President may provide any exceptions (with prior approval) to the attendance requirement.

Tournament Rules: MANDATORY PLAY - CONTINUOUS BATTING ORDER: All Tournament Teams must utilize a continuous batting order that will include all players on the team affidavit present at the start of the game, to appear in the batting order. Each player is required to bat in his/her respective spot in the batting order. A player may be entered and/or re-entered defensively in the game at any time. There are no mandatory DEFENSIVE play requirements! Therefore, playing time may vary based on game situations, and is not guaranteed to be equal. These are competitive teams, and the games will be managed to maximize the chance of victory. Players will probably be asked to play positions they did not play in the regular season.

Travel: All-Star D5 Tournament winning teams move on to the Arizona State Tournament with travel outside of Tucson is probable. Players need to be committed to the team for as long as the team is victorious. (For the 12U & Juniors teams this is potentially all the way to the Little League World Series in Williamsport, Pennsylvania in August.)

Parent Volunteer Commitment: Parent involvement is an important part of the All-Star experience. As you are probably aware, CVLL is a 100% volunteer organization. Without volunteers, CVLL cannot provide All-Star teams nor can AZ District 5 Little League provide and host tournaments. It is an honor to represent CVLL as an All-Star and it is an honor for a league to host an All-Star Tournament. As an All-Star parent, CVLL requires you to volunteer for tournament duties FOR ALL All-Star Division Tournaments CVLL is awarded to hosts by Little League. (This could be a division separate from that of which your child is participating). These volunteer roles include, but are not limited to, scorer's table set-up and breakdown, official score keeping*, official pitch count, announcing, and field prep and breakdown. As part of this commitment, you are agreeing to volunteer with CVLL in one or more of the categories aforementioned.

*Official Scoring personnel must be experienced and able to keep a baseball or softball score book. Gamechanger will not be used by official score keepers.

Attendance Commitment (Parent Initials): _____ I understand the time commitment required and will ensure my player is available for practices and games unless otherwise approved.

All-Star Volunteer (Parent Initials): _____ I understand I will be required to sign up for volunteering during the All-Star season in which my player is participating. Furthermore, I understand I must volunteer to support CVLL when hosting tournaments if my player's team is not traveling in their own tournament. This could be at a date beyond completion of my player's All-Star season.

Team Assignment (Parent Initials): _____ I understand my player will be placed on a team in which CVLL determines their talent will maximize the chance of victory for the selected team. Once a player is placed on a team, this is his/her only option to play on a CVLL All-Star Team.

**Expect team rosters to be announced by May 20th.
Parent meetings and team practices may begin on June 1st.**

Once a player is selected, parents must provide an ORIGINAL Birth Certificate and either;
a) A School Enrollment Form from a school within the CVLL boundary (strongly preferred), or
b) Photocopies of 3 specific residence documents verifying a home address within the CVLL boundary.

The team managers will help with the explanation and collection of acceptable documents.
