"This schedule is a strong, with a fairness rating of about 8.8/10, built through many iterative adjustments to balance a full round-robin across two days while keeping all back-to-back game rules and fixed time slots intact. In simple terms, fairness is hard here because you're trying to solve multiple competing rules at once — every team must play everyone, games must stay in fixed time blocks, some games must stay back-to-back, and rest time has to feel even, but those goals naturally conflict with each other. As a result, what you get is a best-possible compromise where the average time between games is kept fairly similar across teams, with only small differences, rather than a perfectly identical experience for everyone." - Scott Halle
