Max # pitches per day

- 13-16 years old = 95
- 11-12 years old = 85
- 9-10 years old = 75
- 7-8 years old = 50

Days rest per # pitches

- 1 – 20 = No (0) day of rest
- 21-35 = 1 day of rest
- 36-50 = 2 days of rest
- 51-65 = 3 days of rest
- 66 or more = 4 days of rest

NOTE 1: A pitcher who delivers 41 or more pitches in a day **CANNOT** play the position of catcher for the remainder of that day.

NOTE 2: Any player who has played the position of catcher in 4 or more innings is **NOT** eligible to pitch on that calendar day.

Both managers are required to sign at the end of the game to approve the recorded pitch counts
