Ages are "League Ages" based on player's age as of August 31

Tee Ball: 4 – 5 Year Olds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Provides a positive environment for youth and their parents for learning the basic skills of baseball.</li> <li>Focus on keeping players engaged and fostering a love of the game.</li> </ul>
Single A: 6 – 7 Year Olds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Teaches baseball fundamentals through a series of practices and games.</li> <li>Machine pitch games with introduction to player pitch throughout the season.</li> <li>Introduction to standings and playoffs.</li> </ul>
Double A (AA): 8 – 9 Year Olds*	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Prepares players for increased competition by teaching more baseball-specific skills and strategy on small field.</li> <li>Games are player pitch with a focus on developing pitching skills.</li> <li>Introduction to stealing (3rd base only, after pitch has crossed home plate), no leadoffs.</li> <li>Continued development of competitive performance with season standings and playoffs.</li> <li>Participation in AA determined by Manager draft based on player performance at skills evaluation.</li> </ul>
Triple A (AAA): 9 – 10 Year Olds*	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Prepares players for Majors competition with full time player-pitch and added exposure to strategy and competition with standings and playoffs.</li> <li>Expanded stealing (any base, after pitch has crossed home plate), no leadoffs.</li> <li>Participation in AAA determined by Manager draft based on player performance at skills evaluation.</li> <li>9-year-olds not selected for AAA will play AA.</li> </ul>
Majors: 11 – 12 Year Olds*	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Strategy and competition come together as teams play with a focus on game day execution.</li> <li>Expanded stealing (any base, after pitch has crossed home plate), no leadoffs.</li> <li>Participation in Majors determined by Manager draft based on player performance at skills evaluation.</li> <li>11-year-olds not selected for Majors will play AAA.</li> </ul>
Intermediate, Juniors, and Seniors: 13, 14, 15 and 16 Year Olds*	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Full major league baseball rules (leadoffs/stealing at will) on regulation size field (60 foot for Intermediate; 90 foot for Juniors and Seniors).</li> </ul>

\*Qualifies for Post season tournaments (All Stars)
