Rules and Saturday Sideline Behavior:

- All rules from the regular season (playing time, goalkeeper rotation, etc.) will be enforced.

- Additionally: any games ending in a tie will proceed directly to Kicks from the Mark (penalty kicks) to declare a winner. No overtime periods will be played.
- **We have made a modification to the “on the field rule for PK”s” Normally a player must be on the field before the end of regulation in order to participate in Penalty Kicks. We are modifying this. After regulation if the score is tied, you will be given 2 minutes to select any 11 players that are present and, on your roster, to participate in the penalty kicks. This includes your goalkeeper**
- **All other players must remain in the bench area.**
