

Oro Valley Little League All Star Selection Process

Baseball Majors Division (10-12 Year Old Division):

Players for the All-Star team will be selected from players who have been on a Major's team roster and meet Little League International All-Star eligibility. Teams will consist of 10 - 14 players as determined by the All Star Manager. Players will be selected by vote of all Major's managers based upon the following criteria:

1. The most highly skilled players as evidenced by the players' performance during the season overall, or at a specific specialty position such as Pitcher or Catcher.
2. The availability of the players and his/her families to meet the time commitments and obligations required of All Stars.
3. The players character during the course of the year; showing good sportsmanship overall and was respectful of coaches, umpires and teammates.

A meeting of Major Division Managers shall be scheduled by the League before the end of the regular season but no earlier than May 1 and conducted by the President, Vice President, Majors Division Commissioner, and Player Agent. Each manager may nominate players for consideration and discussion. The managers shall then submit confidential written ballots for their 12 highest rated players that have committed themselves available for All Stars Majors team (average ranking will be used as a tie-breaker if needed, if there is still a tie on ranking Major Division All Star Manager will determine the ranking of any "tied" players). A manager does not have to vote for 12 players if he does not feel there are 12 players that fit the 3 requirements listed above, and may choose to list fewer players. The League President or Vice President, Player Agent and Majors Commissioner will determine the top **10** (or fewer if not 10 listed) players as ranked by the Majors Team Managers and those players will be Major Division All Star's representing Oro Valley Little League. If the President/VP, Player Agent, or commissioner cannot be present for the voting, a minimum of two of the four positions must be present to confirm the votes/rankings.

Manager's selections: The Majors All-star Manager may then complete the Majors All-star Team Roster by selecting his/her Manager's picks (if any) to complete the All Star Teams Roster with a maximum of 14 players. The Manager may choose any eligible (meets all requirements for All Star Tournament Play) 10 to 12 year old player from any major's roster. Any 10 or 11 year old selected by the Manager must be approved by the League President. The League President **may** also require the Major's All-star Manager to increase the roster to a minimum of 12 players if there are eligible players available that have declared themselves available and committed to play All-stars.

The teams may not be announced, and no practices or games conducted, until allowed by the Official Rules and Regulations of Little League Baseball and District 5. All voting should be kept strictly confidential. All Star Team will be announced (listed on web site) alphabetically with no mention of ranking, Manager's picks, etc.

Baseball 9-11 Year-Old Division:

Players for the All-Star team will be selected from players who have been on a Major's roster and meet Little League International All-Star eligibility. Teams will consist of 10 - 14 players as determined by the All Star Manager. Players will be selected by vote of all Major's managers based upon the following criteria:

1. The most highly skilled players as evidenced by the players' performance during the season overall, or at a specific specialty position such as Pitcher or Catcher.
2. The availability of the players and his/her families to meet the time commitments and obligations required of All Stars.
3. The players character during the course of the year; showing good sportsmanship overall and was respectful of coaches, umpires and teammates.

A meeting of Major Division Managers shall be scheduled by the League before the end of the regular season but no earlier than May 1 and conducted by the President, Vice President, Majors Division Commissioner, and Player Agent. Each manager may nominate players for consideration and discussion. The managers shall then submit confidential written ballots for their 12 highest rated players that have committed themselves available for the 9-11 All Star team (average ranking will be used as a tie-breaker if needed, if there is still a tie on ranking 9-11 Division All Star Manager will determine the ranking of any "tied" players). A manager does not have to vote for 12 players if he does not feel there are not 12 players that fit the 3 requirements listed above, and may choose to list fewer players. The League President or Vice President, Player Agent and Majors Commissioner will determine the top **10** (or fewer if not 10 listed) players as ranked by the Majors Team Managers and those players will be 9-11 Division All Star's representing Oro Valley Little League. If the President/VP, Player Agent, or commissioner cannot be present for the voting, a minimum of two of the four positions must be present to confirm the votes/rankings.

Manager's selections: The 9-11 All-star Manager may then complete the Majors All-star Team Roster by selecting his/her Manager's picks (if any) to complete the All Star Teams Roster with a maximum of 14 players. The Manager may choose any eligible (meets all requirements for All Star Tournament Play) 10-11 year old player from any majors roster. Any 10 year old selected by the Manager must be approved by the League President. The League President **may** also require the 9-11 All-star Manager to increase the roster to a minimum of 12 players if there are eligible players available that have declared themselves available and committed to play All-stars.

*9-11 year old players that played AAA during the regular season are not eligible for the 9-11 All Star Team unless there are not enough players available to participate and must be approved by the President in such a case.

The teams may not be announced, and no practices or games conducted, until allowed by the Official Rules and Regulations of Little League Baseball and District 5. All voting should be kept strictly confidential. All Star Team will be announced (listed on web site) alphabetically with no mention of ranking, Manager's picks, etc.

Baseball 8-10 Year Old Division:

Players for the All-Star team will be selected from players who have been on a Major's or AAA team roster and meet Little League International All-Star eligibility. Teams will consist of 10 - 14 players as determined by the All Star Manager. Players will be selected by vote of all AAA and Majors managers based upon the following criteria:

1. The most highly skilled players as evidenced by the players' performance during the season overall, or at a specific specialty position such as Pitcher or Catcher.
2. The availability of the players and his/her families to meet the time commitments and obligations required of All Stars.
3. The players character during the course of the year; showing good sportsmanship overall and was respectful of coaches, umpires and teammates.

A meeting of AAA & Majors Division Managers shall be scheduled by the League before the end of the regular season but no earlier than May 1 and conducted by the President, Vice President, Majors Division Commissioner, and Player Agent. Each manager may nominate players for consideration and discussion. The managers shall then submit confidential written ballots for their 12 highest rated players that have committed themselves available for the 9-10 All Stars team (ties are broken as follows, 1st - all Majors players over AAA players; 2nd - average ranking, 3rd - 9-10 Division All Star Manager). A manager does not have to vote for 12 players if he does not feel there are not 12 players that fit the 3 requirements listed above, and may choose to list fewer players. The League President or Vice President, Player Agent and Majors Commissioner will determine the top **10** (or fewer if not 10 listed) players as ranked by the AAA & Majors Team Managers and those players will be 10 Division All Star's representing Oro Valley Little League. If the President/VP, Player Agent, or commissioner cannot be present for the voting, a minimum of two of the four positions must be present to confirm the votes/rankings.

Manager's selections: The 8-10 All-star Manager may then complete the 8-10 All-star Team Roster by selecting his/her Manager's picks (if any) to complete the All Star Teams Roster with a maximum of 14 players. The Manager may choose any eligible (meets all requirements for All Star Tournament Play) 8-10 year old player from any major's or AAA roster. Any 8 or 9 year old selected by the Manager must be approved by the League President. The League President **may** also require the 8-10 All-star Manager to increase the roster to a minimum of 12 players if there are eligible players available that have declared themselves available and committed to play All-stars.

*8-10 year old players that played AA during the regular season are not eligible for the 8-10 All Star Team unless there are not enough players available to participate and must be approved by the president in such a case.

The teams may not be announced, and no practices or games conducted, until allowed by the Official Rules and Regulations of Little League Baseball and District 5. All voting should be kept strictly confidential. All Star Team will be announced (listed on web site) alphabetically with no mention of ranking, Manager's picks, etc.

MANAGER AND COACH SELECTION

All Divisions: Before the All Star player selection meeting, a manager will be selected by vote, with the League President, the Vice President, the Major's commissioner, AAA Commissioner and the Player Agent ("The All-Star Committee") each getting one vote. The President will cast one additional vote in the event of a tie due to someone not being present or abstaining from voting. Interested managers and coaching candidates must complete Managers All Star application and submit by date set by league. The President will develop a list of eligible candidates. Each manager, upon his/her election will then nominate 2 coaches for their All-star team from any division managers and coaches that are in good standing with the league and are listed as a coach or manager on a team in the league. ***Only Managers and Coaches rostered on a Majors Team are eligible to coach/manage Majors All Stars.** Using the voting process above, The All-Star Committee must approve the coaching nominees
