



BRL COVID-19 Quarantine Guide

Reminder: Everyone signed a document stating they would follow the COVID-19 Rules. All tests, symptoms, close contact, etc. must be reported by email to covid@bocalittleleague.com Failure to do so risks your team forfeiting any game player when a player or coach had knowledge of COVID-19 symptoms or a COVID-19 positive test.

Event	Quarantine
Symptoms of COVID-19	Person must: (a) get tested before returning; (b) Wait ten days after the onset of symptoms.
Test Positive for COVID-19	Person can return 10-days after 1st positive test was administered and no longer have COVID-19 symptoms
<i>Unvaccinated</i> Person has Close Contact with a person that tests positive for COVID-19 if the contact was within 48 hours of the close contact.	10-days after the last close contact with the COVID-19 positive person.
<i>Unvaccinated</i> Person Has Close Contact with a person quarantined after testing positive for COVID-19.	10-days after the last close contact with the COVID-19 person.
<i>Unvaccinated</i> Person has Close Contact with a person that has symptoms of COVID-19.	10-days after the last close contact with the person unless the person with symptoms provides a negative PCR test administered more than 48-hours after the close contact.
<i>Unvaccinated</i> Person has Close Contact with a person that develops symptoms of COVID-19 in the 48-72 hours after the close contact.	10-days after the last close contact with the person unless the person with symptoms provides a negative PCR test administered after the close contact.
A person in the household of the <i>unvaccinated</i> player/coach tests positive for COVID-19	The player/coach must quarantine for 10-days after the end of the family member's quarantine (i.e.: the end of the family member's quarantine plus 10-days)
<i>Unvaccinated</i> player/coach has Close Contact with a person that was in contact with a COVID-19 Positive Person (Secondary contact)	No quarantine at this time but additional facts and updates may be requested.
<i>Vaccinated</i> person exposed to COVID-19 Positive, <i>Vaccinated</i> person shows symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.	10-days after the person (i) tests positive; or (ii) developed symptoms. Person cannot return until symptoms are gone.
Player/Coach Notified As Close Contact By School or Other Organization (Vaccination status not relevant)	Player Must Report the Contact and Above Rules Will Apply
Player/Coach on Team Tests Positive for COVID-19 or Develops Symptoms of COVID-19 Within 48-hours of Team Event	All team activities will be canceled until the 8 th day after the exposure. No player/coach will be permitted to return if experiencing symptoms of COVID-19.
Player/Coach on Opposing Team Tests Positive for COVID-19 or Develops Symptoms of COVID-19 Within 48-hours of Team Event	There will be no presumptive quarantine for the entire opposing team. The COVID commissioner and/or board will attempt to identify any player/coach that was in close contact with the COVID-19 positive person.

- "An infected person can spread COVID-19 starting from 48 hours (or 2 days) before the person has any symptoms or tests positive for COVID-19." See [HERE](#).
- Close Contact - Within six feet for fifteen minutes. See [HERE](#). As an example, the following are NOT considered close contacts: cashier at the grocery store for the COVID-19 + person; pharmacist for the COVID-19 + person; being in line of front of the person at the store. See [HERE](#).
